Westlake Girls' Golf 2021

This is the official team document for the 2021 Westlake High School Girls' Golf team. This document must be carefully read and understood by all student-athletes and parents or legal guardians of those desiring to participate. Failure to comply will deem the athlete ineligible to participate during the 2021 season. The key information is as follows:

- 1. <u>Number of Participants:</u> The Girls' Golf team will allow all who so desire to participate. There is not a maximum number of participants.
- <u>Tryouts</u>: All who desire to participate will make the team, however, you must have all of your eligibility items in by March 15th. Varsity is defined as golfers 1-8 and all other golfers are JV. As the season progresses the Varsity and JV teams will change according to the performances at competitions. <u>The Season</u>: The season officially begins Monday March 1, 2021 and will run until the completion of the Utah State Girls' Golf Championships ending May 11, 2021.
- 3. <u>Practice</u>: During the season we will hold practice at 2:00 pm each day after school. Our home course will be divided between The Ranches and Talon's Cove. Practice attendance is mandatory and is essential to achieving a high level of performance this season. On the rare occasion that something does conflict and prevent attendance at practice, contact Coach Romo WELL before practice time. <u>Missing practice will result in being held out of match competitions.</u>
- 4. <u>Competition Schedule:</u> See attached schedule
- 5. <u>Fundraising/Booster Club:</u> Throughout the season we may have fundraising opportunities. These fundraisers would help subsidize the cost of tournament fees, green fees, travel expenses, and spirit pack fees. We are currently looking for ideas and parents to run the Booster club. If you are interested please contact Coach Romo.
- 6. <u>Fees:</u> The fees for Girls Golf are as follows: Required fees:
  - \$100 Participation fee
  - \$120 Game Day fee
  - **\$65** Green fees
  - **\$90** Personal Uniform (collared short sleeve shirt & pants)
  - **\$100** Equipment fee, transportation, banquet
  - Optional fees:
    - (Available Online)
      - o Includes Under Armor: Short and Long Sleeve Shirt, Shell Jacket, Sweats
      - Duffle Bag/Backpack
      - Custom Socks, and Hats
      - Team Shorts.
      - Rain Jacket

Fees will be paid to the financial office in the school.

- 8. <u>Academic Eligibility:</u> In order to be deemed eligible by the UHSAA and Westlake High School a student-athlete must have no F's from any of their classes from 3rd term 2020-21. If an athlete

has such grades please come and meet with Coach Romo so that this can be resolved before the season begins. Academics are the reason we are in school; never allow anything to compromise your performance in the classroom. Additionally Coach Romo will be checking grades periodically during the season and suspensions from competition will apply. Suspensions may be but are not limited to the following:

- Poor grades
- Poor attendance
- Poor citizenship
- Teacher complaints of disrespectful or inappropriate behavior in class
- 9. <u>Sportsmanship:</u> All participating student-athletes will be required to show sportsmanship to all competitors and teammates at all times. Poor sportsmanship is defined by the coaches as verbal harassment or taunting, unnecessary contact such as pushing or tripping of others, and/or use of profanities directly or indirectly or any other act that is seen as offensive or demeaning by the coaching staff. If poor sportsmanship is shown by the student-athlete they will be disciplined as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> offense: verbal warning from the coach
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: suspended from the next competition
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: terminated from the team
- 10. <u>Moral Conduct:</u> All participating student-athletes will be required to live by the following moral code of conduct:
  - No cheating in school or otherwise
  - No use of any illegal substance, i.e. alcohol, tobacco, performance enhancing drugs, etc
  - Appropriate conduct when dealing with those of the same or opposite sex
  - Abide by all school, state and federal laws

A violation of any of these rules may result in an immediate termination from the team and a 1year probationary period. If a student-athlete is suspended their re-admittance to the team will be evaluated by the coaches and either granted or denied accordingly. All disciplinary actions will refer to and follow Westlake, Alpine School District, and UHSAA guidelines.

11. <u>Additional Information:</u> If a student-athlete gets injured at home or otherwise please let the coaches know ASAP so that adjustments can be made accordingly. If a student-athlete has a pre-existing condition such as asthma, breathing problems, or previous injuries that may prevent full participation, please let the coaches know if you have not already done so. All student-athletes MUST have a doctor's physical before they are allowed to participate with the team in either practice or competition. Additionally all student-athletes must be insured by some type of health insurance. If there is currently no insurance in place that change must be made before the student-athlete is allowed to participate. Alpine School District offers a cheap athletic health insurance, if interested contact Coach Romo.
