



SAGE TESTING



WESTLAKE HIGH SCHOOL

Westlake High School was established in 2009. The school operates on a quarter system with 180 days of classroom instruction per vear. There are 110 certified faculty members, eight counselors, four assistant principals, and one principal. We are one of the fastest growing high schools in Utah with a current enrollment of 2851 students. In the fall of 2017. we are anticipating an additional 300 students, which would bring our enrollment to nearly 3200 students.

WHS COMMUNITY

The Westlake High Community serves the students of Eagle Mountain, Saratoga Springs, Cedar Fort and Fairfield. The Eagle Mountain and Saratoga Springs areas are rapidly growing communities in Northern Utah County. The number of residents continually increase each year. There are two middle schools (grades 7.8.9) and twelve elementary schools that feed Westlake High.
