1. All students must apply for admissions to UVU by going to www.uvu.edu/concurrent
2. After applying you will receive a UV ID in 3 to 5 days
3. Westlake will receive next year's CRN numbers sometime later in the spring
4. Once you have a UV ID, you will need to log in and register for your classes with UVU using the CRN number available on the Westlake Counseling Website or print out in D252 or counseling office.
