2023 Graduation Information

Class Theme: "The Future Is Ours"

There are just a few short weeks of school left before graduation. Below you will find all of the information about graduation and senior activities.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students need to complete **ALL** graduation credits in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. Graduation requirements must be completed by Wednesday, May 17th at 2:45pm. Please work with your counselor if you have any questions.

CAP & GOWNS

Cap and gowns will be distributed on Wednesday, April 19th at 12pm in the main gym. If you miss the date and need to pick up a cap, tassel, and/or gown, you can do so by paying the finance office \$50 for the cap, tassel, and gown, \$25 for the cap and tassel, or \$16 for a tassel only. Graduates also need to pick up a stole, which will be collected after the Commencement Exercises. All graduates will be wearing the proper attire: Navy blue cap and gown, with light blue stole, or Light blue cap and gown with navy blue stole. Tassels will start on the right side of the cap, and when prompted to, graduates will move them to the left side.

CORDS, MEDALS, & SASHES

- Honor Cords (gold) can be worn IF graduates paid for and received them from the Westlake Finance Office. Two cords for high honor roll (3.9 4.0), and one cord for honor roll (3.7 3.899). See section below.
- National Honors Society cords can be worn light blue cord if wearing navy blue gown, and dark blue cord if wearing light blue gown. Eligible recipients will receive them at the finance office.
- Sterling Scholar (silver) cords can be worn IF graduates received them at Senior Evening of Excellence. One cord for each Sterling Scholar, and 2 for Sterling Scholar State Finalists.
- Medals can be worn IF graduates received them at any one of our four awards nights Fine Arts Gala, CTE Awards Night, Senior Evening of Excellence, or Thunder Awards.
- Sashes other than the stole (that will be given at Cap & Gown distribution) cannot be worn.

CORDS

Honor cords will be handed out during cap and gown distribution. After that, they will be handed out at the finance office window. They are \$6 each. Seniors who earn a full 28-credit diploma are eligible for honor cords. Those that have a cumulative GPA of 3.9 - 4.0 can receive two (2) gold cords, while those that have a cumulative GPA of 3.7 - 3.899 can receive one (1) gold cord. A letter will be mailed home for those who are eligible. An alphabetized list will also be posted on the front office window.

THUNDER SCHOLARS (Top 10%)

Thunder Scholars will receive a medal to wear at graduation. Receiving this award is a very high honor and students should be recognized for their academic successes. This is calculated using a student's ACT score, GPA, and the number of AP, Concurrent Enrollment and language bridge classes (successfully completed). The top 10% of Thunder Scholars will be awarded and recognized at a point during graduation, while the top 4% will be awarded and recognized by sitting on the stand throughout graduation. A luncheon will be held for the top 10% on Friday, May 12th at 12pm in the media center. The list of Thunder Scholars will be posted on the front office window as well as a congratulatory letter sent personally to each one.

PHOTO OPPORTUNITIES

The only photo opportunities will be held on Saturday, April 29th from 9am - 12pm and Thursday, May 18th from 7-8pm. The giant hammer and W, along with the big blow up Thor will be set up in the commons area. Parents and graduates are welcome to come during that time and take pictures. Please note: there will not be a photographer taking pictures – you must bring your own.

CHROMEBOOK RETURN / BUYBACKS

Seniors can begin turning in their Chromebooks to the media center on May 12th. If you are looking to buy back an eligible Chromebook (\$30), you can do so—more details will follow.

GRADUATION DAY

Graduation will be held on Friday, May 26th at 12pm at the BYU Marriott Center. There is no limit on how many spectators we can have! Here are some important things you need to know about this venue:

- The Marriott Center has a clear bag policy, meaning that ALL items brought into the venue must be in a clear bag no exceptions.
- Confetti cannons, balloons, banners, artificial noisemakers, and fan face signs are **NOT** allowed in the Marriott Center,
- Parking is available on the south and north sides, as well as several parking lots from the football stadium to the Marriott Center.
- Parent entrance is between portals C Q (south side)
- Graduate drop off is on the south side of the Marriott Center. Navy Blue gowns will enter through the east side and Light Blue gowns will enter through the west side.
- Graduates should arrive at 11am dressed in appropriate clothing.
- The program will be live streamed if you have family and friends that cannot attend in person.

DIPLOMA PICK-UP

Diplomas can be picked up for those graduates who have completed the graduation requirements, in the counseling office from 8am - 12pm Monday through Thursday during the month of June. Diplomas will not be handed out at the Marriott Center – only the blank diploma covers.

SENIOR END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES

As we celebrate the Class of 2023, there are upcoming events that are happening that we hope all seniors will be a part of. Tickets to all activities are available in the Westlake Finance Office. Tickets can also be purchased online. The activities are as follows:

- **Senior Panoramic Picture:** Wednesday, April 26th at 11am in the football stadium.
- **Senior Dinner Dance:** Friday, May 12th at Grove Station from 6 10pm. Food trucks will be at the venue with different options for dinner and a soda bar and dessert will be provided. Awards will start at 8:00pm. This is not a date, but is semi-formal and is for WHS seniors only. The ticket price includes dinner from one of the food trucks, unlimited soda bar, dessert, games followed by a night of awards and fun. Tickets to this event must be purchased in the finance office no exceptions or refunds will be granted. **TICKETS WILL NOT BE SOLD AT THE DOOR.** Parents can send baby pictures to <a href="whits:whit
- **Senior Field Day:** Wednesday, May 17th at 11:30am on the grass field by the auxiliary gyms. This activity is full of games and fun, as well as the traditional painting of the "W". This will last until approximately 1pm.
- Senior Lagoon Day: Thursday, May 18th. The total cost is \$90-bus cost is \$36 and the Lagoon ticket is \$54. Buses will leave Westlake at 8am and return around 5pm (the park closes at 4pm). Private vehicles will not be allowed in the park students must ride the bus to and from Lagoon. Students are required to bring their own money with them for lunch and food. TICKETS ARE PRESALE ONLY AND MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE FINANCE OFFICE BEFORE THE DEADLINE. THEY WILL NOT BE SOLD ONLINE AND THE PURCHASE WILL BE SPLIT INTO TWO TO COVER THE LAGOON TICKET AND BUS COSTS INDIVIDUALLY! STUDENTS MUST BE CLEARED FOR GRADUATION IN ORDER TO ATTEND LAGOON DAY! NO EXCEPTIONS OR REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED. There is a limited number of seats on the buses so don't wait to buy your ticket.
- **Senior Sunset:** On Monday, May 22nd seniors will have a chance to get together to celebrate the end of the year. The senior sunset is a tradition held in the Westlake stadium. Tyson Foods will provide dinner. There will be treats and games. This event is free of charge and will go from 6 9pm.
- **All-Night Grad Party:** Friday, May 26th Saturday, May 27th at Provo Beach from 11pm 2:30am. Note: This is the day of graduation! Check-in begins at 10pm at Westlake. Buses will leave at 10:30pm. Seniors will travel by bus to Provo Beach in Provo. Activities include flowrider, bowling, arcade, laser tag and more. It also includes unlimited drinks and 1 ice cream cone. Buses will return to Westlake at approximately 2:30am on Saturday, May 27th. **STUDENTS MUST RIDE THE BUS TO AND FROM THE VENUE NO EXCEPTIONS!** The cost is \$40.

 - o A **video** of yourself delivering the speech (2 minutes)--Please create your video using Loom. Click here for a 5-min. tutorial on how to set up Loom.
